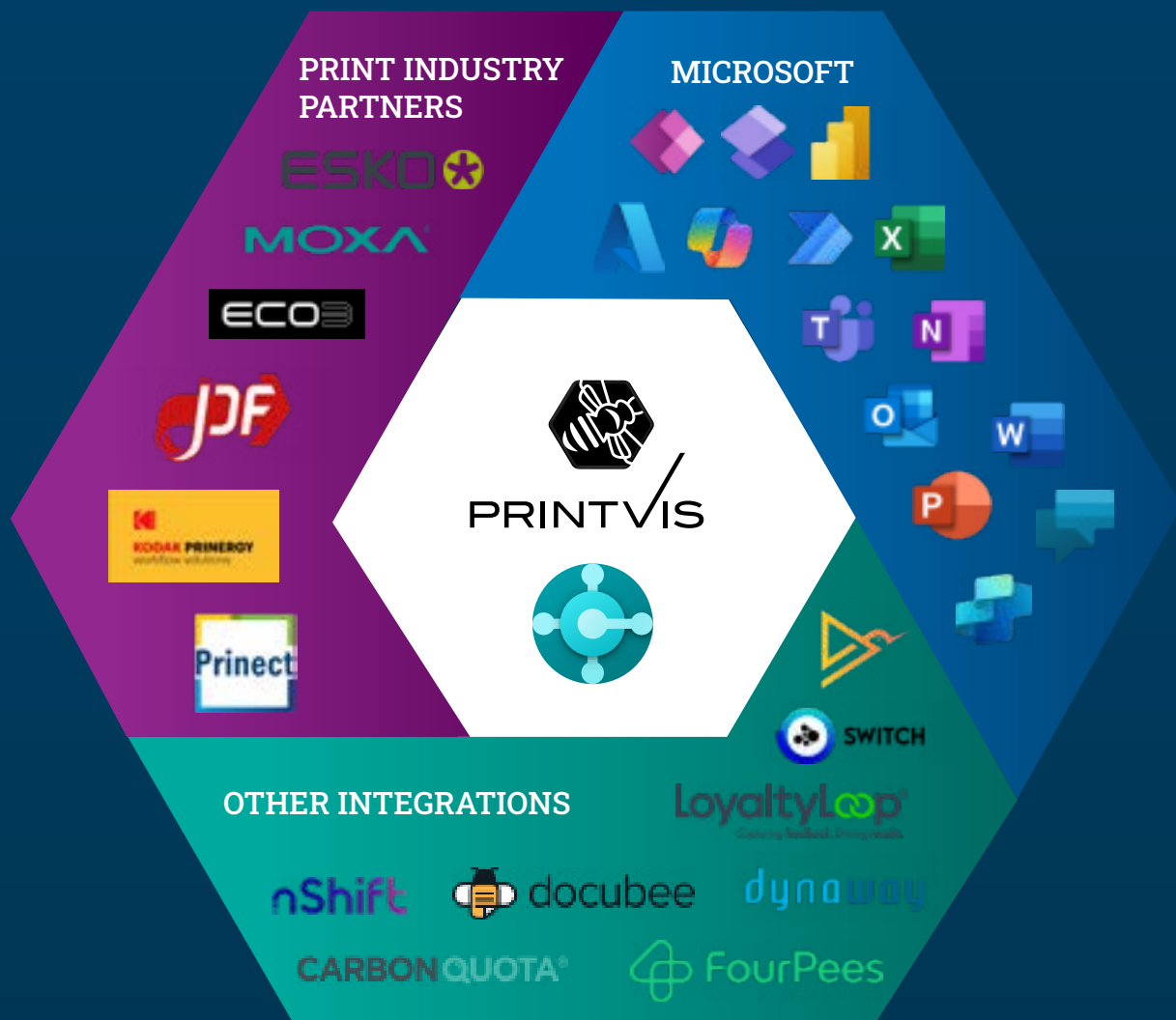

<p>Commercial Print</p> <p>A classic commercial printer produces business cards, books, magazines, brochures, postcards, posters, and more under one roof. Most PrintVis users have 20+ employees and run multiple presses, from digital sheet-fed to multi-tower offset web. Equipment varies, customers often place repeat orders, and manufacturers frequently stock products for fulfillment. <p>Flexible Packaging</p> <p>Flexible packaging manufacturing (pouch and bag converting) prints on thin laminated film, which is slitted and converted into bags for food or consumer goods. These businesses have the most complex WIP and inventory requirements in graphic arts manufacturing. <p>Folding Carton</p> <p>Folding Carton manufacturing is in some ways similar to commercial print in that much of the equipment is the same, but differs in many important ways. Customers are much more likely to place repeat orders expect the manufacturer to stock products for fulfillment.
